As many of you know, our "word of the year" in 2021 was "Restore." After a trying year of lockdowns in 2020, followed by many more COVID difficulties throughout 2021, we felt it was important to pour into our teams, as well as the women we minister to around the world, by specifically focusing on restoration. Toward this end, we directed our attention to the passage in Psalm 23 that shares how the Lord restores our soul as he continues to bring healing, even throughout this trying time.

For Christmas 2022, we will expand this soap fundraiser into a full on TWR Women of Hope Christmas market in which we will be able to offer more than just soap. This market may include pottery, jewelry, tote bags, personalized/sublimated cups – you name it! By putting on this fundraiser, we will enable people to share heartfelt, homemade gifts with their loved ones while partnering with us to share the gift of hope with women around the world and across generations. All proceeds will go to the ministry's New Development project fund.

This campaign has the potential to reach individuals, in the name of Jesus, far beyond TWR Women of Hope's normal audience, but it will not be possible without your support.
