Marli Spieker shares her vision for a new ministry outreach project, called Project Hannah, focused on awareness, prayer and radio programs for unreached women around the world.



2001

Project Hannah is growing at a rapid rate with at least 70 countries represented and the prayer calendar translated into 15 languages.

The first-ever prayer luncheon and calendar, The Heartbeat newsletter and *Women of Hope* radio program come to fruition. Global teams are also established, and women are gathering to join in prayer and fasting for the salvation of marginalized women.

2007

Project Hannah reaches its 10th anniversary with global coordinators sharing testimonies of God's faithfulness across their regions. The prayer calendar is available in 27 languages with women praying in 99 countries.

2016-17

After 33 years of ministry, Marli Spieker retires. Dr. Peggy Banks assumes the role of global ministry director, and the ministry is rebranded as TWR Women of Hope.



With prayer intercessors in 125 countries and Women of Hope available in 70+ languages, we continue to bring hope to women globally as we launch our new program, Precious and Beloved, as well as Hope Market.



We are so thrilled to share with you another exciting way that God continues to build TWR Women of Hope. This Christmas season, we are launching our first-ever Hope Market! The inception of this wonderful project was the result of an overwhelmingly positive response to our Soap for Hope campaign, during which a dear sister in Christ offered the proceeds of her homemade artisanal soaps to fund new projects being developed in various parts of the world. We could have never dreamed how this idea would grow, but leave it to our God to go beyond all that we could ask or imagine.

This year we are offering a comprehensive online marketplace, which will run for a month, made up of handcrafted gifts by local artisans. Many vendors and different products will be represented, and the proceeds will go to our New Development Fund. Each gift will be paired with an aspect of our ministry that aligns with that vendor's heart and will come with a "Receive"

and Remember" card. The card will serve as a sweet reminder for each recipient to pray for women of that specific focus.

Our special projects coordinator, Brianna Oakley, shares the mission behind Hope Market and what we are looking forward to most as a team:

"We are so excited about building community as well as casting a wider net to those who would not ordinarily interact with TWR Women of Hope. We want the ministry not only to benefit from the generosity of its supporters but also to invest in them by providing a platform for their gifts and talents to be used. And we want to pray for every one of you just as you have faithfully prayed for this ministry. This market will encourage all to give with a purpose, receive humbly and remember to pray for women around the world."

We absolutely could not carry out this dream without our incredible team of vendors, volunteers, intercessors, supporters and donors.

There are many accomplishments that we could highlight, but I am convinced they would not have taken place without the Lord's grace as well as the dedication of many women who have gone before us and continue to serve with us.

I am especially humbled by how God built this ministry, sustained us, and continues to grow our teams for his glory. As I consider my role as global director, I am especially grateful that he would invite me to be a part of the work he is doing through women around the world and across generations.

When people ask me what's my favorite part of the job, I can honestly say it is my joy to be a firsthand witness of God's provision and faithfulness. That's the case whether we are talking about the blessings received by our ministry teams or by the many women reached through our audio programs, our leadership development and our prayer groups. We have seen God demonstrate his power time and time again, yet we've also seen his tender mercy. He has answered countless prayers that affirm our confidence in his Word: "Out of my distress I called on

the Lord; the Lord answered me and set me free." (Ps. 118:5)

One of the most recent examples in which I witnessed God's faithfulness came during my travels to the Faroe Islands. I arrived to speak at a women's conference where I was met with over 350 women who gathered to worship the Lord and learn from the speakers chosen for the three-day event. After sharing a message on "A Woman After God's Own Heart," I was able to connect with several women as they shared their hearts with me and as the Holy Spirit guided our time together in prayer and counsel.

TWR Women of Hope exists as a ministry not because of our own efforts but because God's heart is filled with love and compassion for women everywhere who are hurting. As we seek the Father's will and direction for what's ahead, we know that his heart and spirit must first fill us if we are to then fulfill his calling. "We love because he first loved us." (1 John 4:19)

Friends, I want to remind you that you are deeply loved by the one who created the entire world. God sees you in the situation you're in and knows every hair on your head. Let us be fueled by his love for us so that we may have compassion for others and continue using media, small-group
